CURRENT CONSTRUCTION:

From June until July 10, 2017, construction will continue 39th Street which will impact the pedestrian walking path to University Avenue. On-site signage will direct pedestrians to an alternative walking route through University of Calgary Family Housing.

Alberta Childrens Hospital will be installing an irrigation connection and this work will require a section of McLaurin Street (formerly known as West Campus Drive NW) to be closed. Closures will alternate directions ensuring one lane remains open at all times. Barricades and signage will be in place redirecting traffic during this time. No traffic impacts for vehicles or bike routes are anticipated in this work area. Expect traffic delays during high peak hours.

Bus stop #4037 has been temporarily moved from 39th Street to 32nd Avenue.

The construction activity and improvements to 39th Street will include:

- New trees
- New multi-use path
- Street paving
- Utility and landscaping work

2 UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION:

Starting in July 2017, Childrens Way near the intersection on Smith Street will be closed which will require vehicles, buses, bikes and pedestrians to take alternative routes to access Lot 5 off of Childrens Way. In addition, expect traffic delays during high peak hours.

The construction activity and improvements on Childrens Way will include:

- New sidewalks
- Newly paved road
- Planting of new trees and sod
- Upgraded infrastructure new water lines, upgraded storm & sanitary utilities to facilitate ongoing development

3 LONG TERM UPDATE:

University District has deployed the 2017 construction program until October 2017, which will result in new and improved roads/pathways, landscaping enhancements as well as improvements to the North Pond. West Campus Development Trust will provide monthly updates on construction activity and traffic detours. If there are any impacts to pedestrian access and bike routes, updates will be provided as necessary to ensure your safety as construction proceeds.
