WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

SNOW

University District is committed to creating a safe environment for the community. We have assumed responsibility for snow removal from the City of

Calgary for many pathways in University District, allowing for timely action including snow removal on ancillary pathways that the City of Calgary may not cover.

The City of Calgary Bylaw (20M88) requires sidewalks and public areas to be cleared within 24 hours of snowfall. We will be taking an additional measure by proactively clearing pedestrian pathways the morning after there are trace accumulations of snow. Roadways and plowing will occur during snow events with accumulations exceeding 2.5 inches.

Snow removal along University Avenue for doorways, pedestrian pathways, planters, and intersections will be done after each snowfall to eliminate accumulations, drifting snow, and ice build-up. If necessary, arrangements may also be made for the relocation, trucking, and dumping of snow piles.

NOISE BYLAW EXEMPTIONS

The City of Calgary Noise Bylaw (32M2023) is temporarily lifted for 48 hours after snowfall to safely clear pathways in a timely manner.

RESIDENTIAL BOULEVARDS

Condominiums are responsible for snow removal on residential boulevards adjacent to their property, mirroring the responsibility of single-family homes for clearing their sidewalks.

SMITH STREET PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

Following a 'Warrant Analysis', we have been approved for a full signal light at the intersection of Smith Street NW and University Avenue NW. We believe this change will enhance the safety for pedestrians and vehicle access. We are currently in queue with the City of Calgary for the installation phase. Please stay tuned for more details.

BLOCK 22 PARKING NOW OPEN
