WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH

CAMBRIDGE MANOR & MAPLE GROUNDBREAKING

Nature of the work: Groundbreaking on Block 7 occurred on May 17. This is a seniors housing development between The Brenda Strafford Foundation (Cambridge Manor) and Truman (Maple).

Impacts: No direct impacts as a result of construction, will see increased construction vehicle traffic on University Avenue.

BLOCK 22 (GROCERY STORE BLOCK)

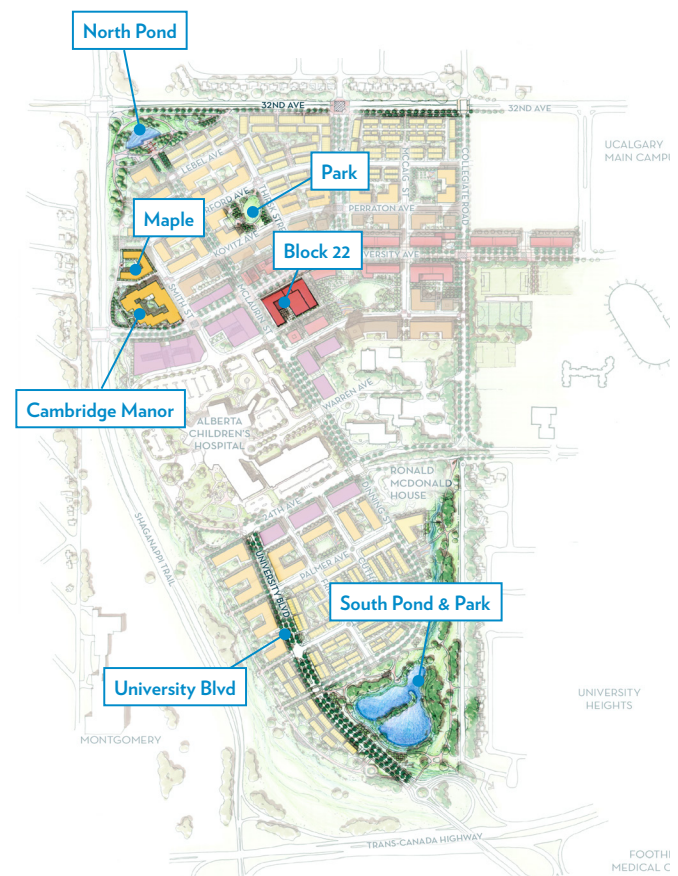
Nature of the work: Crews are constructing the parkade and vertical construction will begin this summer.

Impacts: Intermittent concrete pouring which may result in sporadic lane closures. If in the case of a prolonged closure, we will provide advance notice and instructions.

SOUTH POND & PARK UPGRADES

Nature of the work: Improvements and upgrades to the stormwater management infrastructure of the pond and restoration and repairs to the landscape.

Impacts: To accommodate construction, a series of road closures and detour roads will be in place. Please watch for signage.
